 - Commitment to the coordinated fight against IUU fishing by strengthening the (MCS) mechanisms, by adopting the conclusions and recommendations of studies on the implementation of regional programs
 - On-board observers
 - ☐ Harmonized Port State Inspection in the ATLAFCO region
- ☐ The principle of sustainable use of marine living resources
 - Reaffirm that the sustainable use of marine living resources based on the best scientific evidence available is essential to the food security, livelihood and harmonious development of all member countries,
 - Commit to adopting this principle in the fisheries management policies

- Strengthening ATLAFCO
 - ☐ commit to strengthen the ATLAFCO Institution:
 - Study the mechanisms for institutional anchoring of ATLAFCO to the African Union institutions (MoU with AU/IBAR)
 - Support the operationalization of **coordination mechanisms** established between ATLAFCO and relevant regional and international institutions
 - Examine the legal mechanisms to elevate our Conference to the status of a **Regional Fisheries Management Organization** (**RFMO**) with binding management measures
- ☐ The consolidation of the African cooperation
 - □ Strive for better securing the Member States' interests, consolidating the African position in international bodies dealing with fisheries, and ensuring effective and active participation:
 - ☐ Take concerted actions at every international organization in order to better reflect the interests and concerns of **African countries**.









- Defining the orientations and the priorities of action to be undertaken with a view to maximizing the socio-economic benefits of sustainable exploitation of the fishery resources in the African Atlantic region.
- The strategic axis selected concern topics that transcend national borders and require a committed regional cooperation and solidarity between the States and between the regional institutions by pooling the efforts and means










- Conservation and sustainable use of fisheries resources
