As included in the annual work programme submitted to the Commission:


- 1. Fighting against IUU fishing (including dialogue, better coordination of MCD...).

Work Priorities for Y10 (II)


- 5. Improving **transparency** and **good governance** in the Indian and Atlantic Oceans.




